Dear Mr. Whalen:

You inquire whether a city of the second class may contract with the board of county commissioners for the latter to provide, through the office of county sheriff, police protection in the city. Such contracts are authorized by K.S.A. 1972 Supp. 12-2903, et seq., and by Article 12, Section 5, of the Kansas Constitution, conferring powers of home rule on Kansas cities.
