Dear Mr. Bickford:

You advise that on September 20, 1974, the Board of Regents adopted the following minute:

"It was moved by Mr. Jackson and seconded by Mr. Helman that the Board of Regents authorize the payment of an additional 41 days salary to cover sick leave for Assistant Professor Fort A. Verser, to be paid from Defense Civil Preparedness contract funds, subject to the approval of the Attorney General."

You advised that Professor Verser, who has been paid from funds received under a federal contract, is now disabled and unable to return to work. Sufficient monies remain to permit payment of 41 days of sick leave beyond that allowed by the institution if this is permissible. So long as the proposed payment of sick leave is consistent with the terms of the contract under which the monies were received, we find no legal objection to action of the Board authorizing payment of extended sick leave in the instance in question.
