Dear Mr. Frickey:

This is to confirm our conversation in regard to your inquiry concerning the definition of the phrase, "implement of husbandry".

Local feedlot operations which transport fertilizer to farmers in the immediate vicinity in vehicles designed and adapted exclusively for agricultural purposes and only, incidentally, moved on the highways are exempt from the size and weight limitations of K.S.A. 8-1909.

This office concludes that this type of local enterprise can be distinguished from the fertilizer equipment described in the Attorney General's Opinion No. 74-143. I hope the foregoing will be of assistance to you.
