Dear Mr. Fournier:

You ask my opinion as to whether the Board of Cosmetology is required to invoke the provisions of Board Regulation 69-4-11 in a certain circumstance involving an application from a woman who moved to Kansas from Alaska.

It is my opinion that Regulation 69-4-11 is not applicable to the fact situation you presented to me in your letter. That particular regulation related to students who attended cosmetology school out-of-state and desire to transfer to a Kansas school. That is not the situation described in your letter.

This particular woman has asked if she can register a cosmetologist in Kansas by virtue of her training in Alaska. The regulation that deals with her situation is 69-2-1. I would therefore suggest that the Board examine her application in light of those regulations and make its determination on that basis.
