Synopsis: Pursuant to K.S.A. 1987 Supp. 19-101a(20),
counties may not exempt or change the provisions
contained in K.S.A. 1987 Supp. 19-211. Pertinent
language of Attorney General Opinion No. 87-164 is
amended so as to be consistent with this rule.

As Pratt City and County Attorneys, you recently requested
an opinion from this office. Opinion No. 87-164 was issued to
you on November 23, 1987.


On page eight of that opinion we stated that because it was
non-uniform, K.S.A. 1987 Supp. 19-211 was subject to a
charter resolution. K.S.A. 1987 Supp. 19-101a(20) mandates
a contrary result. Therefore, Attorney General Opinion No.
87-164 is amended in part as to that language. K.S.A. 1987
