Dear Mr. Howe:

You state that a member of the Credit Union Council, created pursuant to K.S.A. Supp. 17-2232, was appointed to fill an unexpired term. Subsequently, he was appointed to a regular three-year term. The question arises whether he is now eligible for appointment to a second regular term.

An analogous situation was considered by this office in the enclosed opinion to Mr. Lewis C. Carter, Clerk of the Supreme Court, in reference to the appointment of members to the Supreme Court Nominating Commission. The conclusion reached in that opinion and the authorities cited are persuasive here. Accordingly, it is our opinion that the member is ineligible for re-appointment.

We are hopeful the foregoing will be of assistance.
